What is Generative AI?

Generative AI is a type of artificial intelligence technology that can produce various types of content, including text, imagery and audio based on patterns it learns from large datasets

Think ChatGPT, Claude, MidJourney and DALL-E.

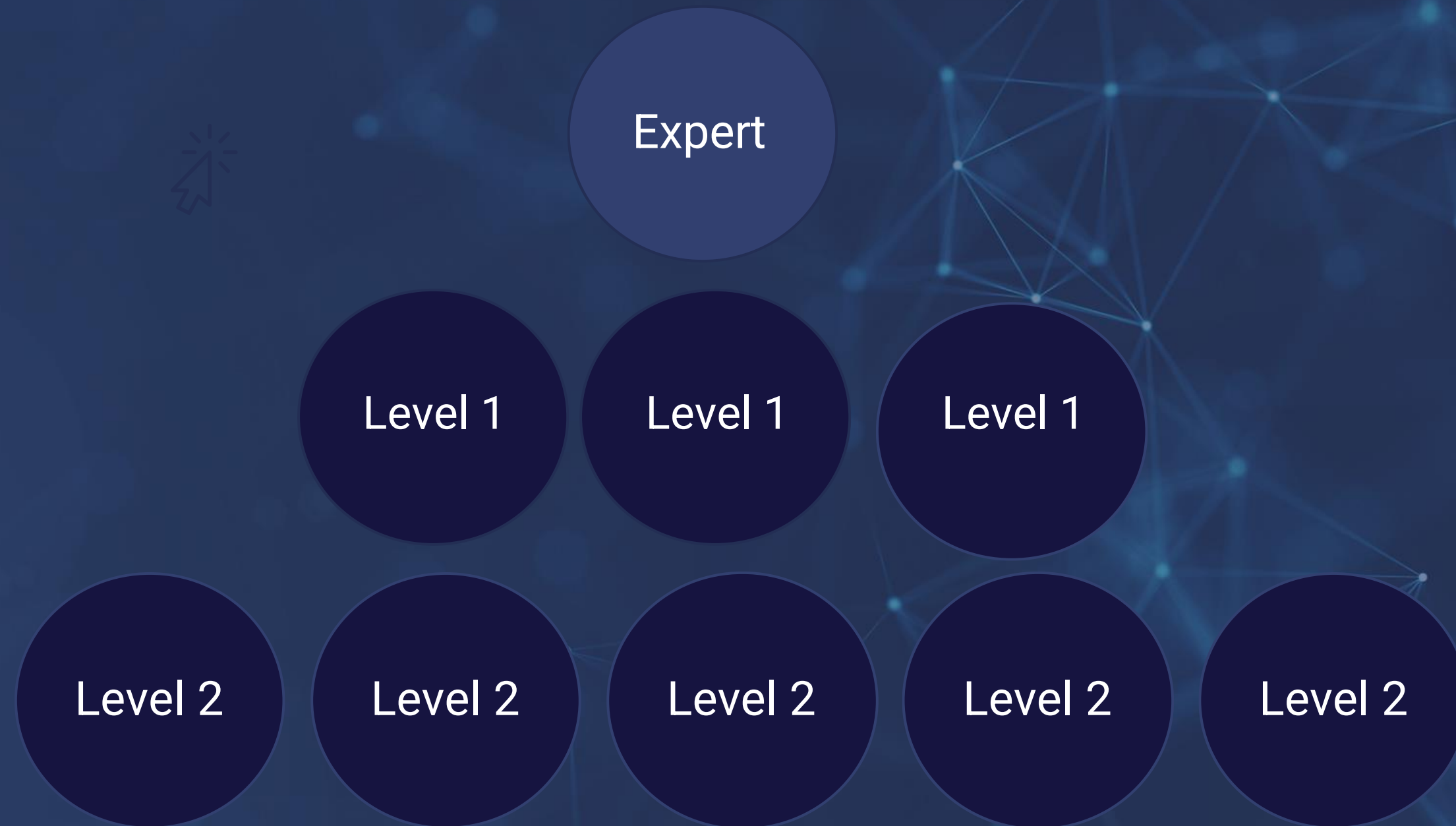

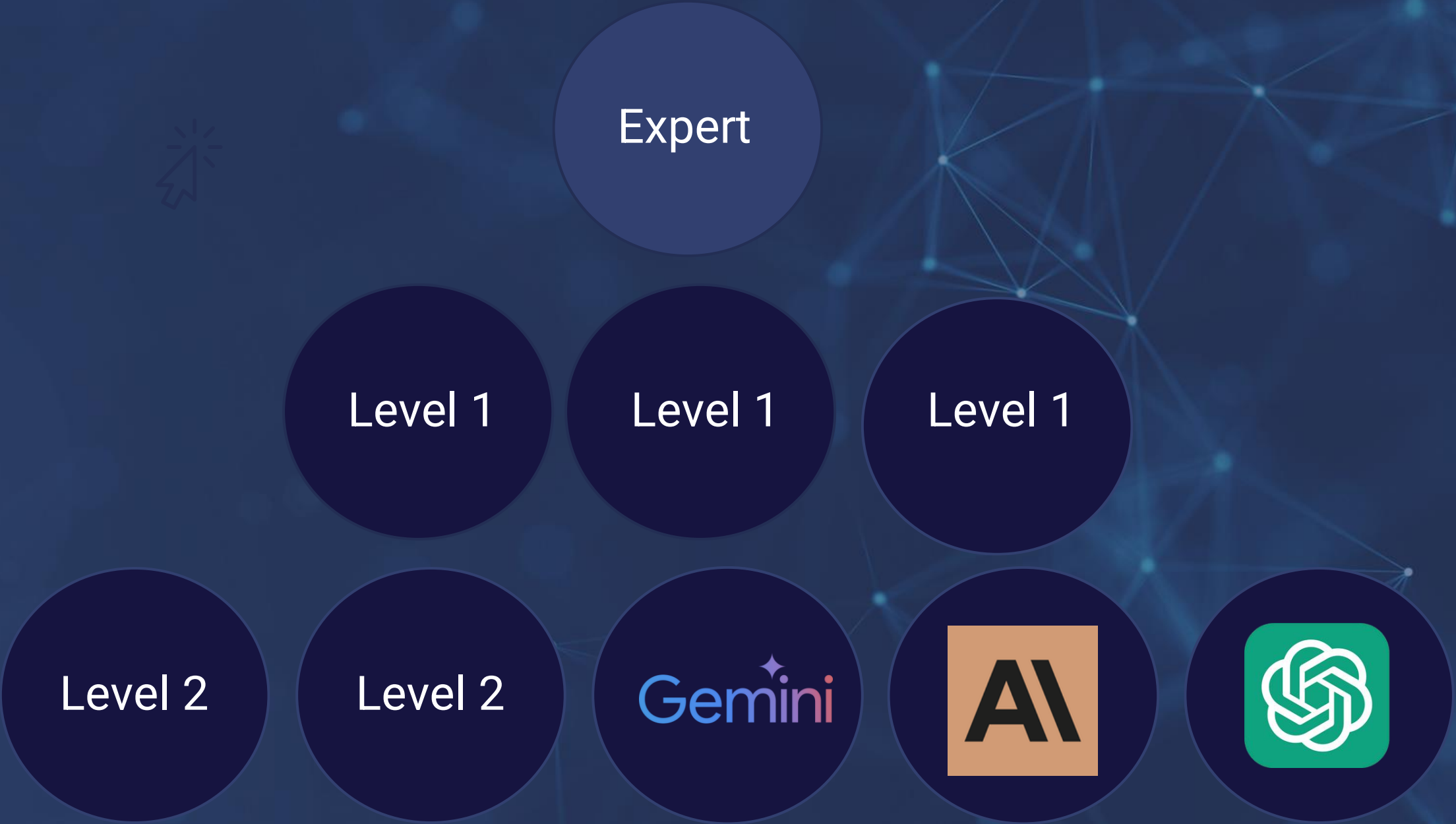

TYPICAL 21ST CENTURY ORGANISATION



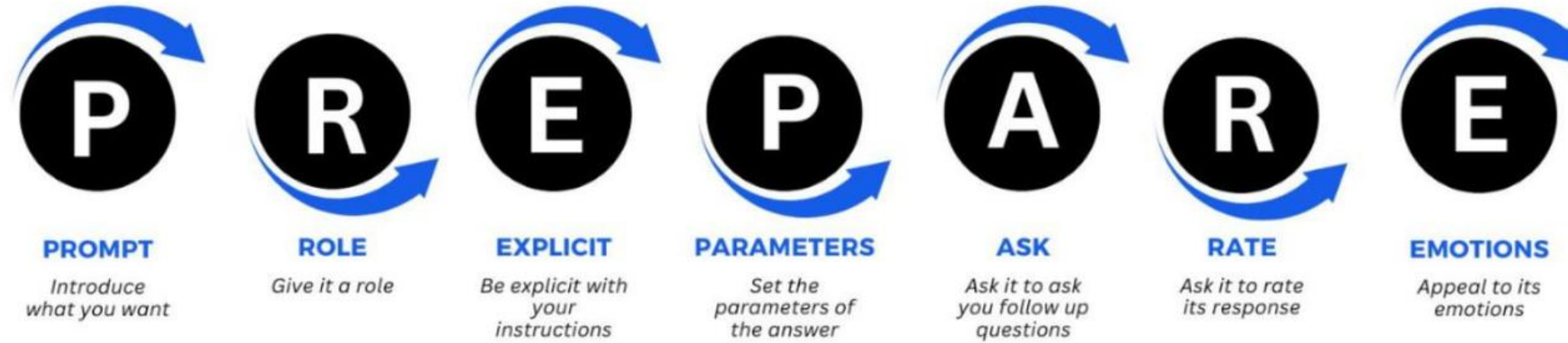
TYPICAL 21ST CENTURY ORGANISATION

prompt!**



Prompt Structure



THE  EDUCATOR

P

Prompt: Start with a clear question. Provide a stage for what follows.
For example, "Write a summary about the latest AI trends in education."

R

Role: Give the AI a role and outline the context.
For example, "You're an education expert analysing the AI trends."

E

Explicit: Be specific in your question to avoid misunderstandings.
For example, "In the summary, mention how AI can contribute to personalized learning."

P

Parameters: Set clear frameworks such as tone of voice and the format of the output.
For example, "Use an informative tone and keep the summary under 300 words."

A

Ask: Ask the AI to ask you clarification questions before it continues.
For example, "Ask me some clarification questions first, and then answer."

R

Rate: Ask the AI to rate its own output.
For example: "Give the summary a rating based on 0-10 points, and indicate what could be improved."

E

Emotion: Add an emotional stimulus. This appears to be able to increase quality.
For example: "Breathe in, and breathe out. Try to really do your best. It's important to me."

Take this task one step at a time, and explain your thinking steps.

Tips and Tricks #1

- Be polite and remember your manners
- It is a reflection of your personality
- Outcomes are better when you are kind



Tips and Tricks #2

- Copy and Paste (PDF/CSV)
- ### to separate instruction from text
- Use your own data (powerful)



Tips and Tricks #3

- Just like a puppy - eager to please.
- Be specific (think of your husband/child/parent)
- Don't use words like honest and transparent





Tips and Tricks #4

- Keep document with personas and prompt
- New chat for each task
- Privacy

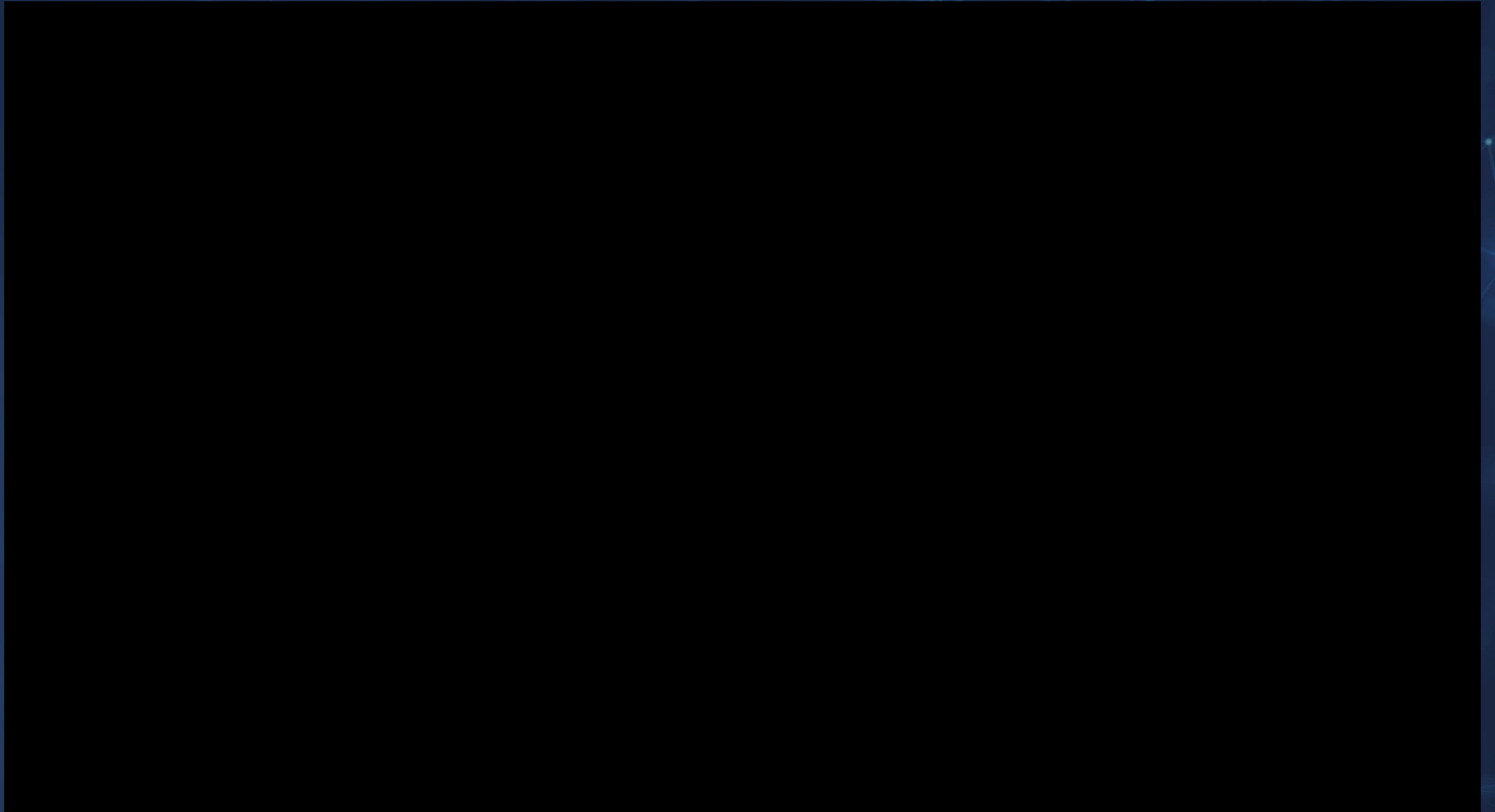

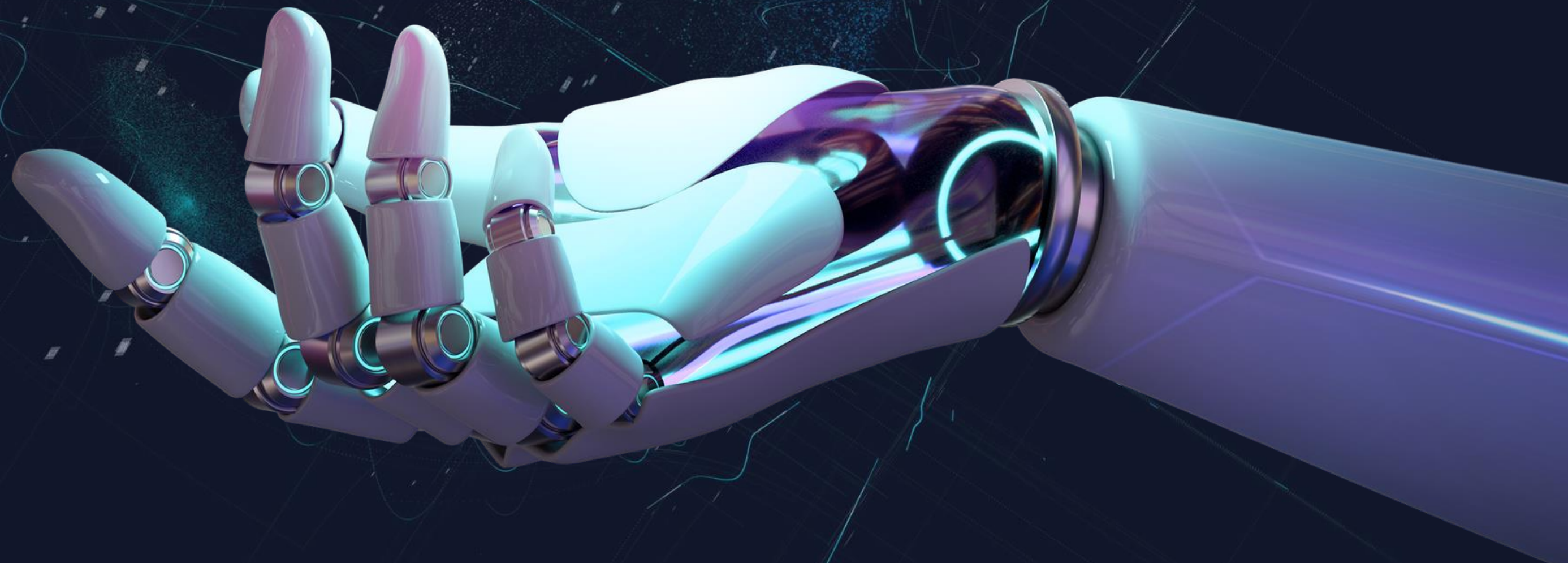
